

Surrey Police Federation Accident claim form

You can use the enclosed form to claim any of the following benefits.

WEEKLY BENEFIT AS A RESULT OF AN ACCIDENT

If you are off work as a result of an accident (either on or off duty) you can claim a weekly benefit of £21 whilst you remain off sick. Please note: -

- There is a 7 day excess
- Claims can be paid for a maximum of 104 weeks including the excess
- Claims are paid upon your return to duty

WEEKLY BENEFIT AS A RESULT OF POST TRAUMATIC STRESS DISORDER (PTSD)

If you are off work due to suffering from Post-Traumatic Stress Disorder as a direct result of a single identifiable incident that is documented in police records then you can claim a weekly benefit. Please note: -

- This PTSD must be of sufficient severity to immediately prevent you entirely performing the duties of a Police Officer
- We will need to ask your GP to confirm that you were diagnosed with PTSD which we will do once we have your return to work form confirming the period of absence
- There is a 7 day excess
- Claims can be paid for a maximum of 104 weeks including the excess
- Claims are paid upon your return to duty.

OTHER ACCIDENT BENEFITS

The policy also provides the following benefits: -

- Permanent Total Disablement from any and every occupation due to an accident – benefit £80,000
- Permanent Total Disablement from your usual occupation due to an accident – benefit £40,000
- Complete loss of two limbs/speech/sight due to an accident – benefit £80,000
- Complete loss of one limb/sight in one eye – benefit £40,000
- Further benefits apply for loss of fingers, toes as a result of an accident – benefit levels vary

If you believe you may be entitled to one of these benefits then please contact either your Federation office or Police Mutual. In assessing a claim for one of these benefits, medical records may be applied for and/or you may be asked to attend a medical.

Please note this policy has a two year limit, this means disablement has to occur within two years from the date of the accident.

NB – If you have been assaulted with a firearm, crossbow, knife or bladed or pointed instrument which results in actual physical injury which renders you unfit for duty for a period of 14 consecutive days or more. You can claim the following benefits

A payment of £1,500 for assault with a firearm or £750 otherwise.
